The town of Wallace has many great museums that offer a package price, so you can spend the day immersing yourself in the cultural history of the area.

The **Northern Pacific Railroad Depot Museum**, a restored depot, was built in 1901. www.npdepot.org

The **Wallace District Mining Museum** tells the story of the richest Silver District on Earth. A history of fortunes made and lost, labor strife and an exhibit on the Great Fire of 1910.

The **Historic Wallace Photo Museum** has thousands of images which tell the fascinating story of life in the Mining District. From the 1880s to 1963, Barnard-Stockbridge studio operated in Wallace. Housed in an historic church designed by renowned architect Kirtland Cutter. www.historicwallacephotomuseum.org



Ready for your outdoor adventures, the **Wallace RV Park** will welcome you and your home away from home. Right her at the Center of the Universe. Located adjacent to City Limits Brew Pub, home of North Idaho Mountain Brewery. Full RV hookups. **For Reservations call 208-753-7121**



The fourth, privately-owned museum in Wallace is the **Oasis Bordello Museum**. The building housed an active bordello until 1988, when the girls hastily left town – leaving everything, except the money, behind. It has remained as they left it and opened as a museum in the 1990s. A tour guide explains the circumstances surrounding their speedy exit. **[208-753-0801]**



Get your adrenaline pumping on the Dragon’s Breath six-story drop. Just one of ten lines featured at Wallace **Silver Streak Ziplines**. Each course offers ‘dual zips’, allowing the option of flying in the ‘superhero’ position and a tandem line allowing side by side zipping. Do not miss the **Center of the Universe** – marked by a special man-hole monument cover at the corners of Bank and Sixth Streets, in downtown Wallace. The town throws a rededication party every year on the 3rd Saturday in September.



Go underground in a former working mine with a retired miner as your guide. Operating for over 40 years, the **Sierra Silver Mine Tour** is one of Idaho's most popular attractions. Take a tour on the trolley around Wallace and up to the Sierra Silver Mine located one mile north of town. Open May–October silverminetour.org [208-752-5151]



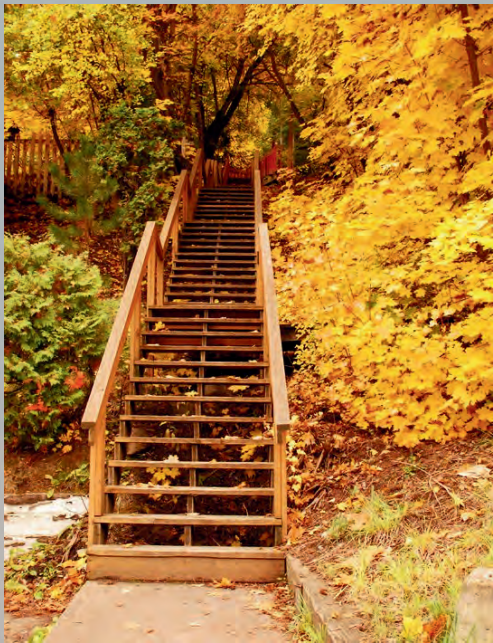
The **Pulaski Tunnel Trail** honors Ranger Ed Pulaski, who saved his crew of 45 men by shepherding them to safety during the 1910 'Big Burn' fires. Today it's a 4-mile roundtrip hike with interpretative signage. Featured on The Travel Channel and PBS American Experience, the trailhead is located one mile south of Wallace on State Route 456.



The 73-mile **Trail of the Coeur d'Alenes** is distinguished as a "Hall of Fame" trail. The asphalt trail is well maintained and has a gentle grade. Bordering rivers, lakes and small towns in Idaho's Panhandle – it offers 20 developed trailheads and 17 scenic waysides with picnic tables and benches. Abundant wildlife includes bald eagles, osprey, herons, otters, beavers, moose, elk, and deer. The 15-mile **Route of the Hiawatha Scenic Bike Trail** winds through lush forest, past waterfalls, over 7 train trestles and through historic 10 train tunnels. Shuttle buses are available to transport bikes and riders back to the top. Designed for all ages and experience levels, it's a gently downhill pedal. Step into history on the Wallace Stair System. Restored stairs can be found at every numbered street from 3rd through 7th. A total of over 800 steps, (the equivalent of 46 stories), the stairs helped early residents of Wallace access their hillside homes. Most stairways are 100 feet long and have 76 to 84 steps, including those with landings and benches.



CRYSTAL GOLD MINE

Nine miles west of Wallace you can find the **Crystal Gold Mine & RV Park**. In 1879 prospectors discovered gold and mined it for three years, before abandoning the site. The mine wasn't discovered again until 1991. The site has been rejuvenated as an historic attraction. Summer tours include gold panning sessions. Goldmine-Idaho.com [208-783-4653]

The entire town of Wallace is listed on the National Register of Historic Places. Take A Walk Through History, a self-guided tour that points out 43 downtown buildings

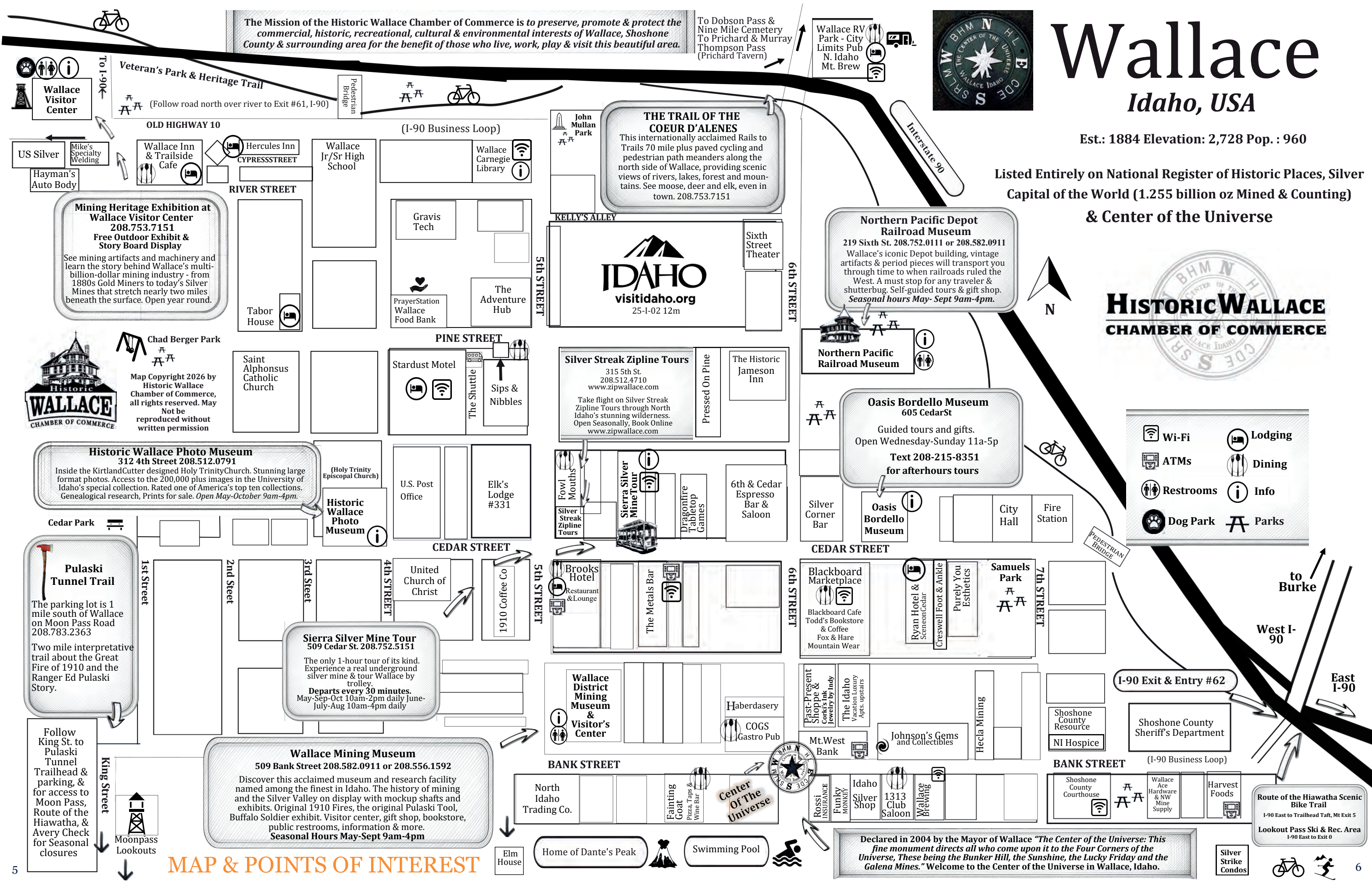


The four-acre **Mining Heritage Exhibit** and park lies along the Coeur d'Alene River adjacent to the Wallace Visitor Center. (Exit 61 from I-90). This free, family-friendly open-air exhibit provides numerous hands-on exhibits and interpretive signs. It also offers 24/7 restrooms year-round, picnic tables, dog park, water and electrical outlets.

At Exit 54 from I-90 you will find the **Sunshine Miners Memorial**, memorializing the Sunshine Mine disaster of 1972. Standing at the mouth of Big Creek Canyon is a statue of a miner, surrounded by 91 miniature tombstones. Every year on May 2nd there is a gathering on Miners Memorial Day.



If skiing is your passion the Silver Valley offers **Lookout Pass Ski & Rec Area** [skilookout.com] and **Silver Mountain** [silvermt.com] ski resorts – operating from November through April. Each resort is within a 15-minute drive of Wallace. **Fourteen snowmobiling trails**, ranging from 12 to 65 miles in length are groomed from mid-December until early March.
